

Faculty Language Requirements

- S7 entrants admitted into the double degree programme are required to fulfill the faculty language requirements of both the Engineering and BA faculties.
- S6 entrants admitted into the double degree programme are required to fulfill the S6 faculty language requirements of the first degree programme and the S7 faculty language requirements of the second degree programme.
- The following exemptions on faculty language requirements will apply to both the S7 and S6 entrants admitted to the double degree programme:
 - (1) Students in this double degree programme who have taken ELT1111 (3 units) would be exempted automatically from taking the course ELT1100 and the corresponding units for the fulfillment of the graduation requirements of the second degree in BA.
 - (2) Students in this double degree programme who have taken CHI1510 (3 units) would be exempted automatically from taking the course CHI1660 and the corresponding units for the fulfillment of the graduation requirements of the second degree in BA.
 - (3) Students in this double degree programme who have taken ELT3112 (3 units) would be exempted automatically from taking the course ELT3110 and the corresponding units for the fulfillment of the graduation requirements of the second degree in BA.

Course and Unit Exemptions

The following course and unit exemptions will apply to students registered for the ERG+BBA or BBA+ERG double degree option:

- (1) Students successfully completing SEG2430 Applied Probability and Statistics (3 units) in their first degree will be exempted from taking and the units of DSE2010 Statistical Analysis for Business Decision I (3 units) in their second degree.
- (2) Students successfully completing SEG3490 Information Systems Management (3 units) in their first degree will be exempted from taking and the units of DSE2050 Information Systems and E-Commerce (4 units) in their second degree.
- (3) Students successfully completing DSE2010 Statistical Analysis for Business Decision I (3 units) in their first degree will be exempted from taking and the units of SEG2430 Applied Probability and Statistics (3 units) in their second degree.
- (4) Students successfully completing DSE2050 Information Systems and E-Commerce (4 units) in their first degree will be exempted from taking and the units of SEG3490 Information Systems Management (3 units) in their second degree.
